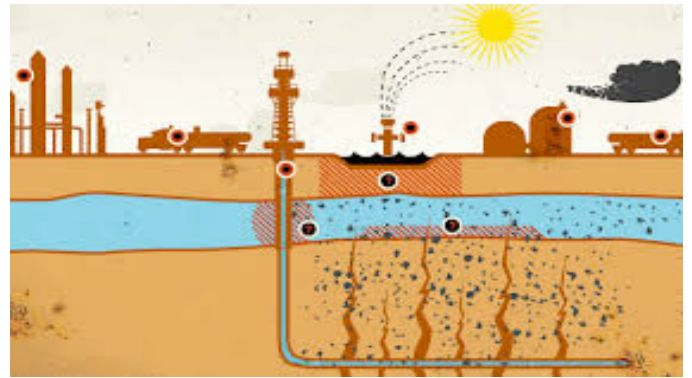


FRACK FREE SOUTH YORKSHIRE



Underneath our area lies one of the world's largest shale-gas fields, the Bowland Shale. Now gas companies and politicians are gearing up to extract the gas and exploit the land and its people.

Local areas already under licence are:

- Alkane Energy have purchased the gas assets at Maltby Colliery and have been granted Licence PEDL043, covering an area including **Maltby, Braithwell, Micklebring, Edlington, Conisbrough and Stainton.**
- Multinational Dart Energy have been granted Licence PEDL200, covering **Thurcroft, Stone, Dinnington, Laughton, Firbeck, Letwell and further south to Worksop and eastwards to Blyth and Retford.** Dart Energy have said they will start drilling here for Coal Bed Methane in 2014.

Our government says these processes are safe, but are refusing to carry out Environmental Impact Assessments. Why?

Our government is relaxing the planning regulations so that it will be easier for the gas companies to drill for unconventional gas.

They know the dangers! People in the U.S. who have had their water supplies contaminated by gas extraction are now forced to rely on bottled water. One company chairman believes "access to water is not a public right".
